Product Description	PTH is a hormone produced by the parathyroid gland that regulates the concentration of calcium and phosphorus in extracellular fluid. This hormone elevates blood Ca ²⁺ levels by dissolving the salts in bone and preventing their renal excretion. It is ...

Application Dilute	Immunohistochemistry (FFPE): 0.5-1ug/ml for 30 min at RT
Application Notes	Optimal dilution of the PTH antibody cocktail should be determined by the researcher.1. Staining of formalin-fixed tissues requires boiling tissue sections in 10mM Citrate buffer, pH 6.0, for 10-20 min followed by cooling at RT for 20 min.2. The prediluted format is supplied in a dropper bottle and is optimized for use in IHC. After epitope retrieval step (if required), drip mAb solution onto the tissue section and incubate at RT for 30 min.
